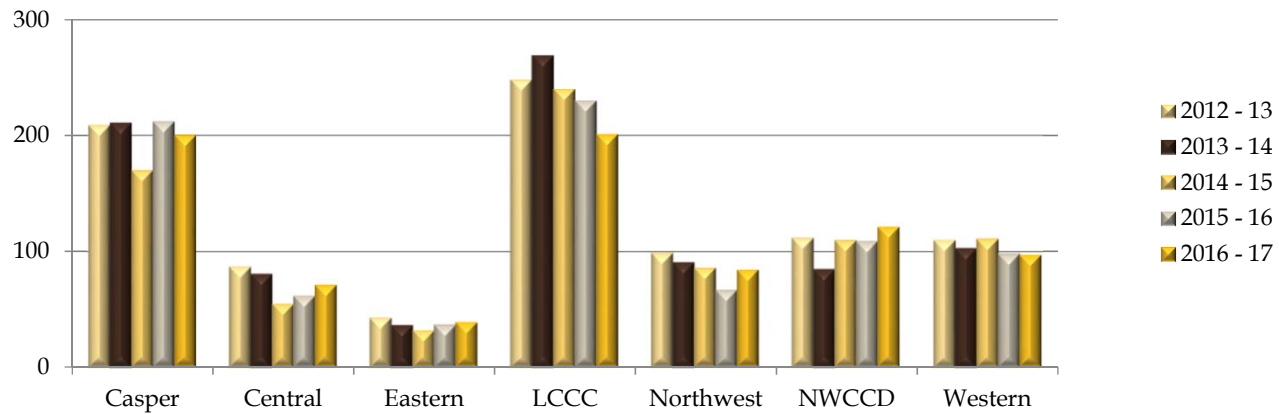

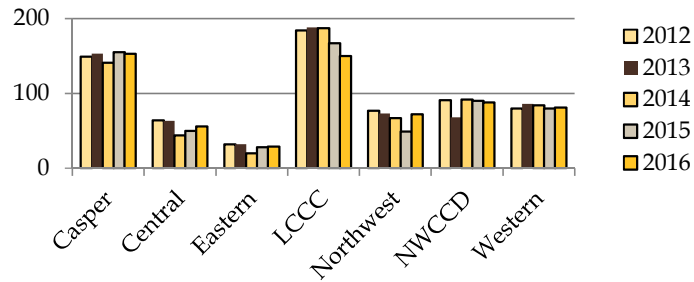
Definition of Terms Used in New Transfer Information

Community College GPA:	Cumulative GPA prior to UW. This GPA may include work from more than one institution.
Fall Semester:	Fall includes students who began in the summer and continued in the fall.
New Transfer Students:	<p>Undergraduate students who previously attended a higher education institution, have been officially admitted to the University of Wyoming (UW), and are attending UW as a degree-seeking student for the first time. This includes students at UW for the first time seeking a second bachelor's degree.</p> <p>Fall 2016 new transfers include those as defined above, who began taking classes during summer or fall 2016. These students are identified only with the most recent college they attended prior to attending UW. Re-enrollees at UW are not counted as new transfers.</p>
Transferred Hours:	<p>Total hours taken for grade prior to UW.</p> <p>This total may include hours from more than one institution.</p>
Undergraduate Students:	This group includes freshmen, sophomores, juniors, seniors, second bachelors, and non-degree undergraduates.
UW Fall '16 Sem GPA:	UW GPAs are for fall semester 2016 only. It is calculated by dividing the students' earned points by earned hours.

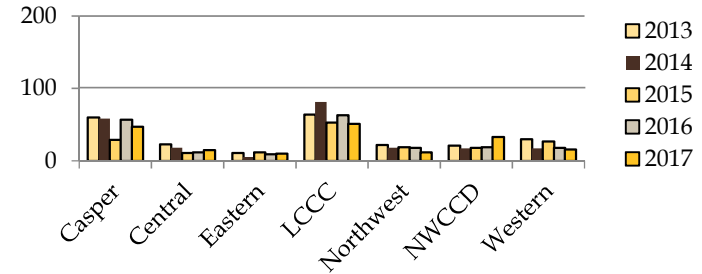
**Figure 1. Headcount of Wyoming Community College Transfers

Fall Semesters



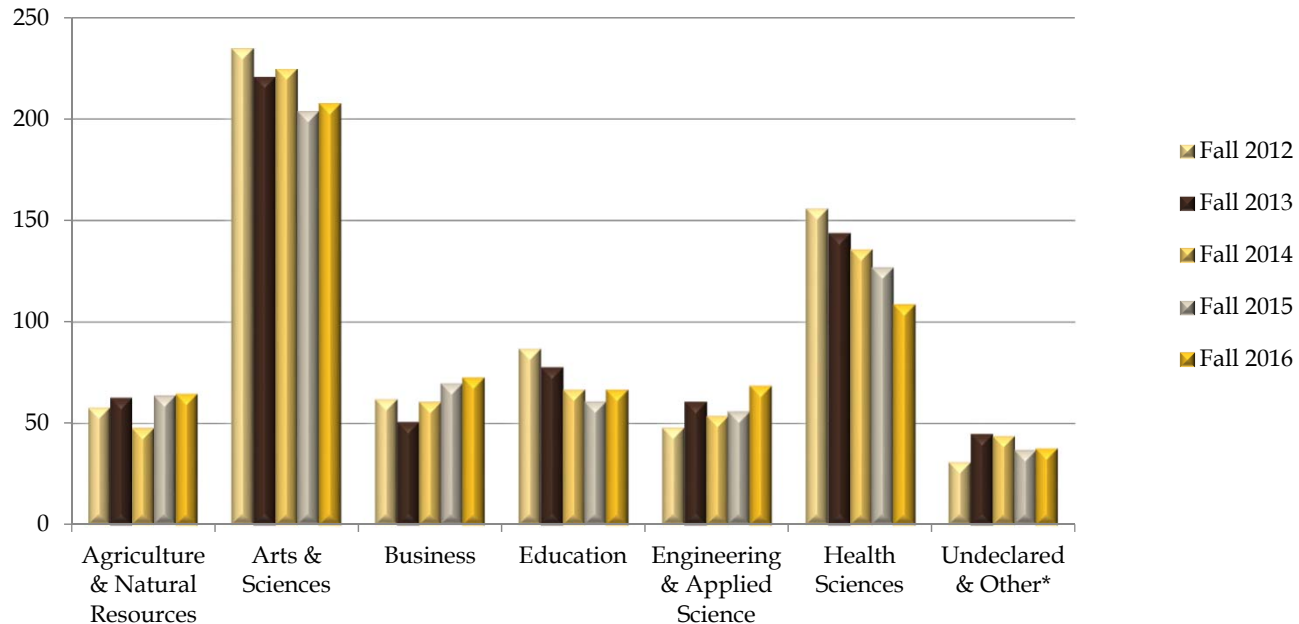

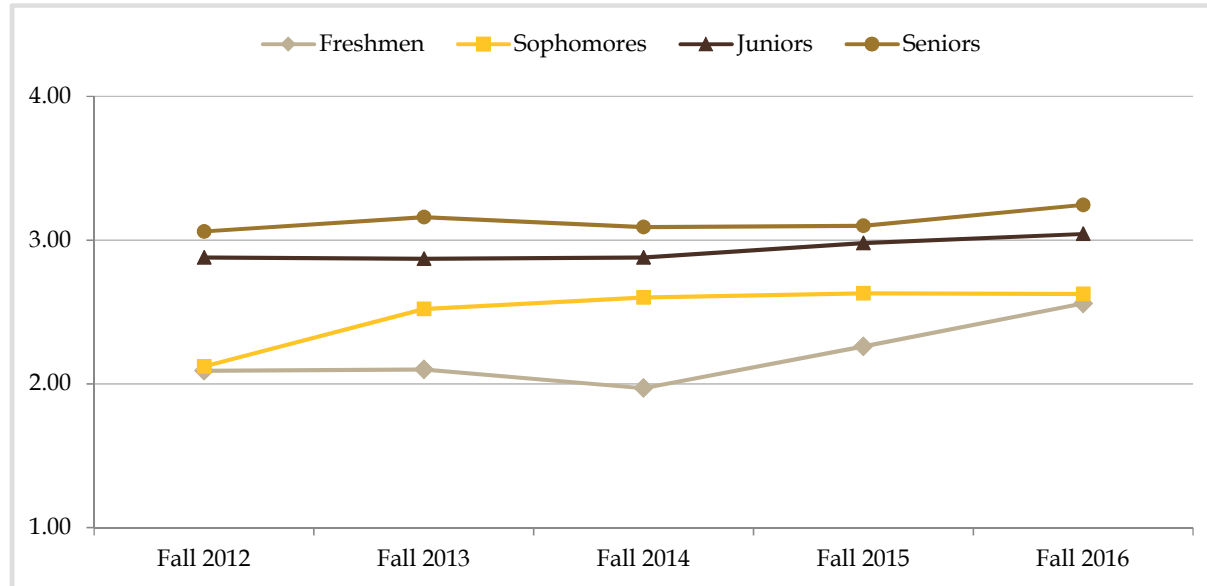

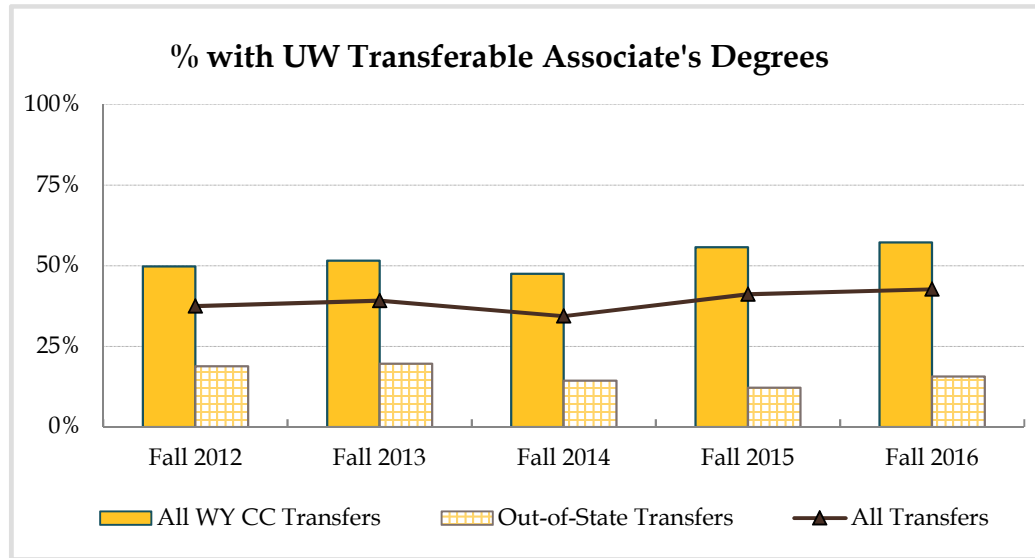
**Figure 5a. Retention & Graduation of Degree-Seeking Transfers from Community Colleges

Fall 2012 - 2016**

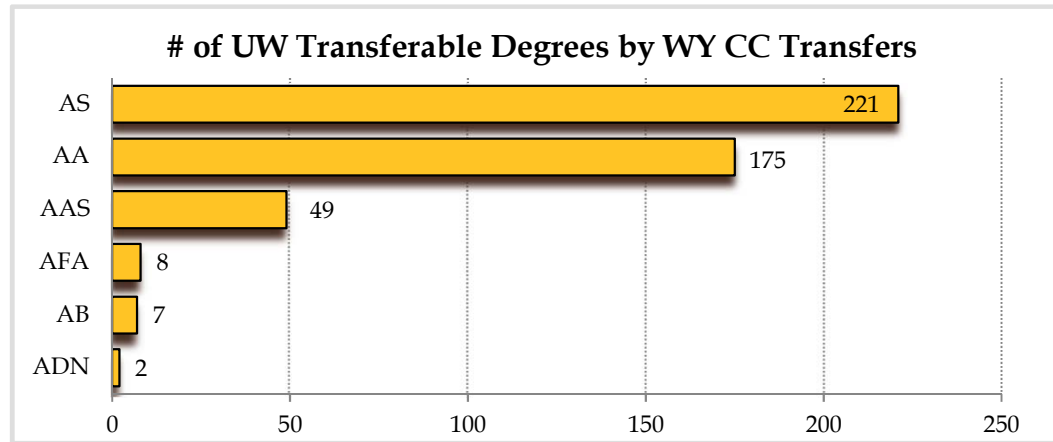

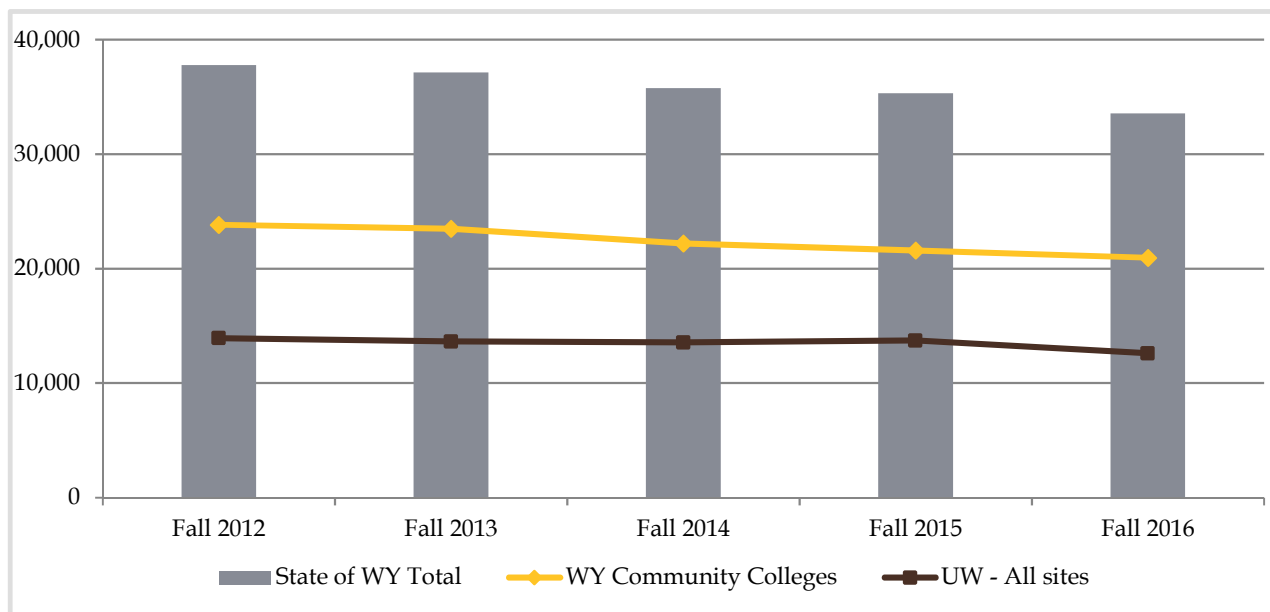
