#### **SENATE RESOLUTION #2528**

TITLE: The Creation of a Mission Statement for the Associated Student Technical Services

**DATE INTRODUCED:** November 15, 2016

**AUTHORS:** Senator Drake and Executive Long

SPONSORS: Senators Fried, Strock, Potter and Zumo; ASTEC

- 1. WHEREAS, the mission of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
- 2. Student Government is to serve our fellow students through accurate representation; and,
- 3. WHEREAS, the Associated Student Technical Services (ASTEC) is a valuable ASUW
- 4. Service for the students of the University of Wyoming (UW), especially Recognized Student
- 5. Organizations (RSOs), as well as UW Departments and non-RSO third parties; and,
- 6. WHEREAS, ASUW considers ASTEC as a primary resource with the intention of spreading
- 7. the messages and ideas of UW students consistently, effectively and professionally; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, ASTEC provides an educational and safe entertainment environment for all
- 9. students who attend ASTEC and StudioWyo events, are trained in operating ASTEC
- 10. equipment, and plan events as an RSO; and,
- 11. WHEREAS, RSOs and programs on campus have stated the direct importance of ASTEC to
- 12. their diverse professional, cultural, and academic programming goals; and,
- 13. WHEREAS, ASUW has declared support for direct student control of ASTEC passed
- 14. through Senate Bill #2432, with additional recommendations for the growth and development
- 15. of the services provided by ASTEC passed through Senate Bill #2464; and,
- 16. WHEREAS, ASTEC provides event technologies to a wide variety of events on campus,
- 17. with the central focus of events largely varying from year to year based upon the campus
- 18. culture and graduating turnover rate of the UW student body; and,
- 19. WHEREAS, each new technology and service that ASTEC provides to meet the needs of

- 20. RSOs, UW Departments, and academic units, comes with unique versatilities and
- 21. vulnerabilities; and,
- 22. WHEREAS, for many years ASTEC has attempted to scale their program according to
- 23. resource limitations, by standardizing and refining their operations, resulting in more
- 24. requests for ASTEC services from all sources; and,
- 25. WHEREAS, in the last eight years, ASTEC transitioned from providing 300 services
- 26. annually to providing an excess of 600 services with more complex technology; and,
- 27. WHEREAS, the ASTEC Billing and Service Policy indicates "RSOs are limited to 16
- 28. weekly events per semester"; and,
- 29. WHEREAS, during Fiscal Year 2017 (FY '17) ASTEC has reached a peak of facilitating
- 30. over 35 events in a single week in order to provide student support and auxiliary services
- 31. across campus; and,
- 32. WHEREAS, this has caused demands on ASTEC which have grown beyond their resources,
- 33. requiring increased financial needs, staffing, and equipment; and,
- 34. WHEREAS, Senate Bill #2458 specified the need and allocation of funds in the ASUW
- 35. budget for an ASTEC equipment reserve fund to accommodate unforeseen circumstances
- 36. and necessary but variable operating costs; and,
- 37. WHEREAS, successful technical services often hinge upon acquiring specific equipment
- 38. compatible with existing infrastructure; and,
- 39. WHEREAS, Senate Bills #1692, #1822, #1932, #1989, #2012, and #2182 specifically
- 40. indicated the need to increase charges in order to fairly pay ASTEC technicians in
- 41. accordance with federal regulations; and,
- 42. WHEREAS, recent funding has been increasingly insufficient to maintain and repair existing

- 43. equipment, provide fair compensation to ASTEC students and staff, and supporting unique
- 44. event circumstances; and,
- 45. WHEREAS, the UW Budget Reduction Plan to realize \$26 million in FY '17 mandates that
- 46. "No overtime, no faculty overload, [and] no additional compensation [be] effective
- 47. immediately" creates problematic constraints on ASTEC staffing to manage and operate all
- 48. requested events within typical business hours; and,
- 49. WHEREAS, ASTEC was developed and operates through the appropriation of student fees
- 50. and the potential for adding additional resources or growth is minimal at this time, reducing
- 51. the scope of ASTEC's services is the next viable solution for stabilization; and,
- 52. WHEREAS, current ASTEC services are being recognized by RSOs of the student body as
- 53. found in preliminary survey results included in Addendum C; and,
- 54. WHEREAS, the UW campus has grown, requiring additional technical services to
- 55. peripheral areas as explained in Senate Bills #2464 and #2501; and,
- 56. WHEREAS, certain peripheral facilities, including the Gateway Center, have provided some
- 57. of their own personnel and equipment, with the possibility of operating peripheral technical
- 58. services independent of ASTEC.
- 59. THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 60. (ASUW) Student Government recommends Associated Student Technical Services (ASTEC)
- 61. to adopt the mission statement outlined in Addendum A; and,
- 62. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that ASUW recommends contacting the organizations
- 63. that have recently reserved ASTEC services listed in Addendum B about their experiences,
- 64. future technical needs, and relationship with ASTEC in order to verify the mission statement
- 65. defined by this legislation; and,

- 66. THEREFORE, ASUW recommends further legislating the specific and sustainable
- 67. limitations that ASTEC would ideally impose beginning in Fiscal Year 2018 concerning, but
- 68. not limited to: capping the number of high caliber events per week, specifying which ASTEC
- 69. services are available to campus entities, and updating ASTEC's billing and service policies
- 70. with these factors, creating a guideline for accommodating student technical needs over the
- 71. next 15 years.

Through ASTEC, students learn to appreciate individual differences and similarities, personal responsibility, and effective communication; develop skills to think objectively and critically, develop citizenship skills, gain greater self-understanding; and to enhance their feelings of engagement, belonging, and loyalty at UW."



### How many events does your RSO host per semester that require ASTEC's services?





### What quality of services does ASTEC provide?


